Highways Report. Oct 25

Items noted this month are as follows.

Galhampton - Smallway lane near Mount pleasant Farm. The edges breaking up as reported last month.

Yarlington - The hole near the village hall remains unrepaired

Queen St /Lodge Hill - some repair activity noted, still more to do .

Junction with Cattle Hill Lane, two holes needing attention as previously reported...

Crockers Hill outside Sticklepark. Hole to repair, the road opposite is crumbling away.

Crockers hill at the triangle in front of the bridge . A pothole already identified by the council for repair

Higher North Town Lane - various holes along this road, could do with some attention as before .

Woolston Rd outside Manor Farm entrance, the 30/60 sign knocked over, metal post snapped. Reported again.

Junction Sandbrook and Corkscrew Lane pothole growing in size.

Sandbrook Lane has had repair work done on many of the holes outside Greenlands.

Re Slip Road onto A303 outside Teals- Still no repair.

Cary Road /Parish Hill Dates 07.00 hrs 27th Oct — 19.00hrs 10th Nov. This is identified as due "Surface Dressing " works, the areas are all marked up in preparation. There will be delays and possibly diversions during this work.

Ridgeway Lane - Road in poor state mainly since the extensive works at the Sewage station. This is also due a road closure on 10th -11th Nov, Scottish and Southern Power work.
