A303 Sparkford roundabout resurfacing

Highways England plans, builds, operates and maintains England's motorways and major A roads. I am writing to let you know we will shortly be carrying out roadworks near to you.

The works

Essential surfacing works need to be carried out at Sparkford roundabout on the A303. To minimise disruption, we'll work overnight when there are fewer vehicles on the road. During the day we will keep the carriageway open as usual.

Dates of work

The work will start on the evening of Friday 10 July and finish on the morning of Saturday 11 July. **Work will take place at night time, between 8pm and 6am.**

Traffic management

Whilst work is taking place, we will need to fully close a section of the A303 (east and westbound). The closure will be from the Podimore Roundabout on the A303 to the Wincanton junction, east of the Sparkford roundabout. A clearly signed diversion route will be in place during this time. Please allow extra time for your journey. Please accept our apologies in advance for any disruption this may cause.

During this closure, access will be available to properties/business within this closure but no through traffic will be allowed. Please approach the gateman at the closure points for access.

We always aim to work to the programme, however unforseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions may mean changes to it. We will notify you of any major changes within the programme via advance roadside warning signs, but please also monitor www.trafficengland.com to keep up to date. We will make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community and travelling public is kept to a minimum.
